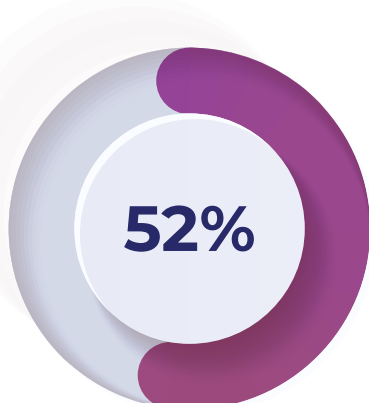

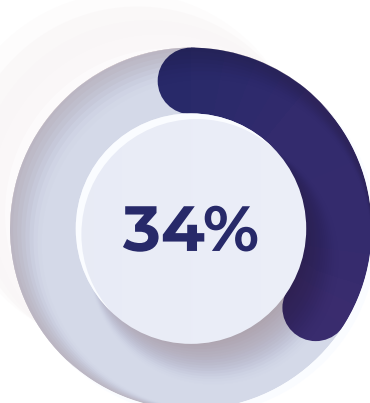
Insurance Labor Market Study Results

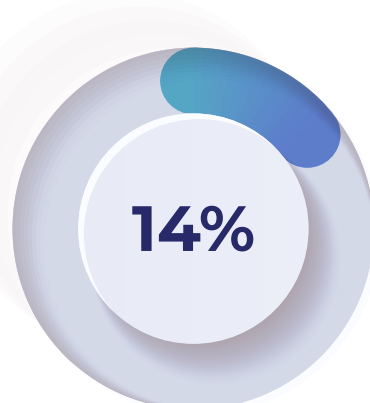
Staffing Expectations

Just **11%** of companies feel **hiring talent** has become **more difficult** compared to last year.



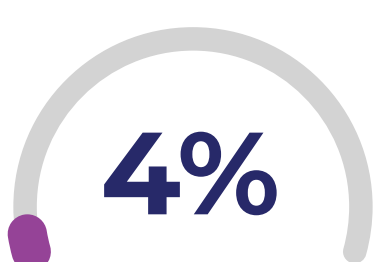
Actuarial, executive and **analytics** roles are considered the most challenging to fill.

Revenue Expectations

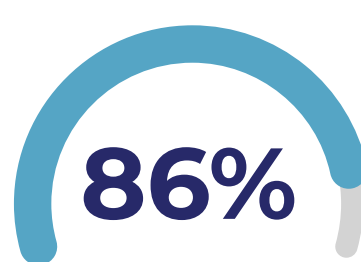


79% of companies expect revenue growth, driven by a change in market share.
